Envirocon Awarded National Safety Council Awards



Envirocon has received safety awards from the National Safety Council, a leading safety advocate. The National Safety Council recognizes organizations that have completed a period of at least 1 million consecutive work hours without an occupational injury or illness resulting in days away from work. Envirocon as a corporation surpassed 1 million safe work hours on November 15, 2014 (May 25, 2013 - November 15, 2014). Each of the major offices received a copy of the plaque to display. Additionally, The Remediation & Geotechnical Services Division surpassed 1,310,000 man/hours on December 31, 2014 (January 1, 2010 - December 31, 2014) and that division has also been awarded a 1 million manhour plaque.
