

## Envirocon Project Wins Prestigious Award



### **Envirocon's Duwamish Project Wins Environmental Dredging Award**

The World Organization of Dredging Associations (WODA) recently held their triennial international conference, which included a gala dinner and awards ceremony where four Environmental Excellence Awards were presented in two categories - Environmental Dredging and Dredging for Coastal Reinforcement. Envirocon was the Prime Contractor for the Project Team that took First Prize for WODA's Environmental Excellence Award for Environmental Dredging. The winning project was Boeing's Plant 2 Sediment Remediation and Urban Waterway Restoration at the Duwamish Waterway in Seattle, Washington.

Envirocon provided extensive mechanical precision dredging of 161,000 cubic yards of contaminated sediments from over one-half mile of the Waterway at an active manufacturing facility, and performed shoreline excavation, rehabilitation, and restoration services over five acres of contiguous intertidal wetlands adjacent to this site. The project site is located within an active, navigable channel that flows directly through a major metropolitan city. Environmental sensitivities included protection of fish species, waterfowl, and other wildlife along with coordination with the Muckleshoot tribe during fishing activities.

## Canadian Operations Update

### ***Envirocon Continues Canadian Growth***

Envirocon continues to be busy in Canada during the first half of 2016 with ongoing project work. This work includes a precision dredging project in Victoria, BC; completion of a slurry wall at a site in Calgary, AB; and completion of an abandoned mine site in remote northwest BC.

Envirocon was awarded a project in January 2016 to perform precision dredging of contaminated sediment at the Esquimalt Harbour on southern Vancouver Island. This harbour is the historic home of Canada's Pacific Naval Fleet, and was in use for over 150 years. The harbour is one of the most contaminated sites in Canada, and is the home of a large graving dock owned by Public Works Canada,

who uses it for ongoing west coast shipbuilding and ship repair activities. The project focused on dredging contaminated sediments offshore of CFB Esquimalt's A Jetty with precise requirements on the amount of over-dredged material allowed. By the end of the project, Envirocon will have dredged approximately 7500 m3 of material, with an over-dredge allowance of approximately 10%.

Envirocon was recently awarded a second project at the Savannah River Nuclear Site for the remedial closure of the 488-1D Ash Basin located at the site in Aiken, South Carolina. Envirocon was selected from a field of five bidders based on a best value determination by proposal evaluators. This work will extend Envirocon's presence onsite. Currently, the team is completing a consolidation and closure project in the 488-4D Ash Basin adjacent to the 1D site.
